A Message from Dale Squires

The 2014 horseshoe season was interesting like usual. Weather played a big part with one tournament rained out and a few others only having singles play. There was an executive change in Prince Albert, a shoulder separation in Swift Current which made decisions on tournament days a little more interesting when locations were changed and dates moved. In the long run everything was kept on schedule.

After the season was done and having discussions with Clara, it was decided to do a few minor repairs at the Prince Albert courts. However, after doing some work on the pits, there was no way to partially do repairs. All the pits were replaced and patio blocks placed in for the throwing platforms. I would like to thank the members of Prince Albert, Paddockwood and Saskatoon clubs who came out to help rebuild the pits. Next year will have a new look for the PA club and I am looking forward to playing there on the new platforms. As you can see, the season continued through into October with the repairs and prolonged the horseshoe season in a different way.

In 2015 Yorkton and Whitewood are going to hold their tournaments on Saturday and Sunday on the May 30th weekend each holding their tournament at their own pits. This was tried two years ago with very good results. HSI will try this again hopefully with a positive result. The end of the year will be on Aug 22 this year so maybe other tournaments can be held later if needed.

In the past, if clubs could afford it they were donating the profits from the concession held at their tournament to HSI. The clubs were given a receipt in that amount to use on the follow-up report as a donation. This year Manitou and the three HSI run tournaments were included to our list of contributors. Instead of burgers which were sold in previous seasons, HSI went with buns, cold cuts, ham, roast beef, chicken salads, cake and coffee for \$5 a person. This was another great idea which made it easier for Denise where in the past she might have to run the tournament along with cooking burgers in some cases. This year there always seemed to be helpers and things went great. In our provincial meeting in July, Gerald brought up the idea to charge \$10 for lunch which was passed by the players. However after thinking about the price and checking on how HSI was doing for the year, it was decided to do lunch for \$5 with coffee only as a free drink. Drinks will be sold for

an extra \$1 each. By the end of the year the profit shown on the concession was almost \$1,000 which doubled what HSI was receiving in the past. So HSI will go with making our own sandwiches, dessert and coffee for \$5 with soft drinks extra like this year and hopefully have another great season in this fundraising effort.

This year I usually had shirts, horseshoes and other items with me to sell for HSI. I will announce this next year because sometimes the items were in the van and not on display. Even with this slight error on my part HSI sold about \$800 worth of merchandise this year. Horseshoes were bought and picked up in Calgary during the Canadians play. Shirts were ordered when needed and there is always some on hand when the shirts start to fade and wear. If anyone needs something this year, just call Dale and he will put you in contact with whatever product is needed. Just to enlighten you on what HSI has in stock for sale....

- ❖ HSI tried to sell sweatshirts but they didn't go very well so they are being sold at half price \$10. There are only 3 large left for sale.
- ❖ horseshoes \$60 a pair if ordered \$20 extra for postage (types - Dean, Dean Slim, Condor, Prostar, Can Am, Simmons, Galinna) Other shoes not listed can be ordered or a connection can be made if HSI doesn't handle that type of horseshoe. Call Dale Squires 1-306-374-8233 for information.

A hockey draft was held over the winter. The clubs were asked to sell 10 drafts each and extras if possible. This was our second try at this event after having a year off with the hockey season shortened by strike action. The first year HSI sold 123 drafts and the second time 153 drafts were sold. This gave HSI a pleasant success in this fundraiser. First place was won by a team that donated it to HSI which made the draft a complete success. The drafts cost \$10 where \$5 goes to HSI and \$5 goes into the payout.

The draft went down to the last night of play to see who would win and how they would finish. There were six other teams within 3 points of third which shows how interesting this fundraiser can be. The hockey draft was continued this year and 177 drafts were sold by the clubs showing another growth spurt. The hockey draft password on the form shows **horseshoe sask** as the entry but because it wasn't deleted from the computer last year it couldn't be used this year so a 1 (one) was added after the sask.
