President's Message

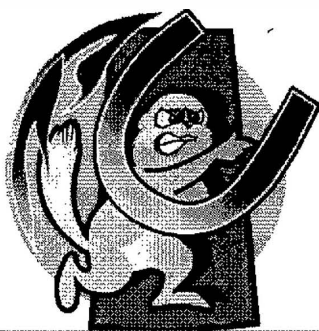

A Message from Dale Squires

This year the amount of players coming out to play at all of HSI tournaments was quite reasonable. HSI had members from Alberta come and play in four of our tournaments. We still need more new players to join and hopefully participate in our tournaments.

In July, Horseshoe Saskatchewan was happy to hear that a building was going to be donated to help improve the horseshoe situation at Manitou Beach. Viktor Falaz offered the building after talking to Millie Strueby, the president of Manitou Beach Horseshoe Club. After discussing the movement of the log hut, the Saskatoon Horseshoe Club decided to clean and move the building in a three week period. The inside of the hut was cleaned out and ready to move. The moving company came and moved the building to the Manitou Beach courts. The area was leveled and ready for the new log hut. A new shed was purchased so the tractor cutting the grass was closer to the pits. The building, after leveling, was repaired to meet municipal code standards. New doors, ramp, deck were added along with lining the walls and ceiling with gyprock. Electricity was brought from the existing hut to supply lights. New metal roofing will be applied in the spring. I would like to thank all the people that helped in all situations to get the building ready to go.

HSI did clinics again this year hoping to get more members involved and promote horseshoes. The amount of participation was reasonable, so when you practice before going to a tournament, keep track of the ringers and points in a 40 shoe format. Play one or two games of practice for a total of four games. Then phone or email the totals to Denise. The cost is \$10 and everyone gets more than the entry fee in payout. Members can play games earlier and send them in. Players can do 3 or 4 clinics earlier and send them in if you are going away. Anyone that doesn't understand the format of the clinics, give Dale a call at 306-374-8233.

In the spring HSI is going to set up a sponsor board for businesses donating money to promote the horseshoe facility along with listing the Canadian Horseshoe Championships. HSI is looking into putting names of donators on wooden plaques, maybe cloth signs

advertising the businesses and people helping horseshoes. If someone has any ideas about the sponsor board, give Dale a call.

This year HSI is hosting the Canadians at Manitou Beach. They are hoping that clubs and members can donate towards the operation of a silent auction. We are going to need items or find sponsors to give something for the auction. A brochure will be assembled for the Canadians. We need all clubs to see if someone would advertise in the booklet.

This year the Western Classic and Canadian Championships are being held August 1st - 2nd and August 4th - 8th at Manitou Beach. HSI is hoping that as many members as possible try to attend during those days.
